

#### HISTORY OF DEBUTANTE COTILLIONS

Black debutante balls, also known as cotillions in the South, have been a part of Black American culture since at least 1895. The first recorded Black debutante ball was in New York in 1778 and was called an "Ethiopian Ball". The balls were a way to present young Black women to society, and to challenge negative stereotypes about how they should look, act, and think. They also emphasized women's education and were a way for organizers to show that Black people were worthy and intelligent.

Black debutante balls gained national attention in the 1950s when singer Nat King Cole presented his daughter at a ball in Los Angeles. The balls were often held in private nightclubs that were popular with celebrities like Marilyn Monroe and Ronald Reagan, but were segregated and expensive, which excluded many young Black women.

Black sororities such as Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., fraternities and community organizations worked to host balls in their communities, and the events became a rite of passage for well-off young women. The balls were also a chance to showcase the work of expert dressmakers, called modistes, whose designs would shine under the ballroom lights. It was not uncommon for mothers to bring their daughters to be fitted by the same modistes who had dressed them decades earlier.

The Central North Alabama Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. is proud to uphold the rich traditions of Debutante Cotillions with our inaugural ball, "A Night of Diamonds and Pearls: A Bridgeton Experience".

#### THE COTILLION SEASON

The Cotillion Season begins with the Welcome Reception. This activity is a must for all Debutantes, parents and members of the Sorority that plan to volunteer. Debutantes will be introduced to their "Violets" at this time. Basic information, questions and concerns, will be addressed and an overview of the Cotillion Season and Ball will be presented.

The Central North Alabama Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. (CNAA) places special emphasis on all planned events, designed to focus on cultural enrichment and skills development that will help Debutantes prepare for life after High School. - ▲ Complete an application
- ▲ Complete a participant registration form
- ▲ Be a resident of the Central North Alabama Alumnae Chapter service area: **Lawrence, Limestone, or Morgan Counties**
- ▲ Be at least a Junior or Senior in high school at the time of the event
- ▲ Secure (3) letters of recommendations; referred sources: Church, Community Organization, Teacher, or Counselor
- ▲ Complete an essay question:
  - **MUST** be typed, double spaced and between 250 and 500 words. Select one (1) of the following questions.
    - How will being a Debutante be beneficial to you? Explain why.
    - Describe your most meaningful achievement(s). How do these relate to your future field of study and/or your future goals?
- ▲ Adhere to the rules and regulations set by Central North Alabama Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.
- ▲ Plan to attend a post-secondary institution upon year of graduation
- ▲ Wear required formal attire at the Cotillion Ball as outlined in subsequent pages and recommended attire to additional activities. Debutantes and escorts are required to provide their own formal dress
- ▲ Submit a participant agreement signed by parent(s) or legal guardian(s)
- ▲ Attend all related functions and activities held between January 2025 and April 2025.
- ▲ Be in good standing in school and in community
- ▲ Be responsive to acquiring characteristics and qualities that would lend themselves to desirable and acceptable social behaviors.
- ▲ Sign and submit the 2025 Debutante Cotillion Season Agreement and Parent Statement of Commitment and Responsibility (these forms should also include the signature of a parent or legal guardian)
- ▲ Submit a **non-refundable** entry fee of \$1000.00
- ▲ Raise the scholarship participation minimum of \$2500.00

#### **Criteria for Winning**

Scholarship winners will be determined by the amount of money raised in advertisements, sponsorships, donations and/or any other approved fundraising initiatives.

General Scholarship Awards – All presented Debutantes who raise the participation minimum in advertisements and donations (combined) will receive a scholarship award. 10%

Top Scholarship Award- This award recognizes the top participant who went above and beyond. 50%

Remaining funds, if any, will go to support CNAA scholarships awarded to service area students and community programming.

#### Charge Back Policy

All planned activities for which an expense is incurred, participants will be required to provide 24-hour notice of non-participation. If the absence is due to death of immediate family member 24-hour notice is not required. Immediate family member consists of mother, father, siblings, and grandparents. It is your responsibility to notify a committee member. If such notice is not provided, there will be \$20 non-attendance fee assessed.

#### **Funds Raised**

Designated times and locations will be provided to collect all monies. These dates will allow you to avoid holding checks and large sums of money.

All required ad forms should be filled out completely and accurately. Participant's names must appear on the memo line of all checks to ensure proper processing and credit. All checks should be made payable to Central North Alabama Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.

If a check is returned, the amount of the dishonored check and associated fees will be deducted from the participant's total should the issue not be resolved.
